Anglo European School Redevelopment

The Anglo European School, in partnership with the Department for Education and Kier Construction, are pleased to announce a public consultation in relation to the proposed redevelopment of the school.

We are currently working on proposals for the regeneration of the school to create an inclusive, inspiring and positive learning environment which reflects its distinctive, international ethos in which we teach and learn.

It is proposed to design a new school building, which will provide modern teaching spaces, a welcoming entrance, new Sixth Form centre and a fabulous school hall/theatre. The proposals will be net zero in operation, and an exemplar building in energy efficiency.

The project also includes significant improvements to the external areas within the school grounds, including two Multi-Use Games Areas, a new amphitheatre, world garden and landscaped area to the south-east of the school, and a reconfiguration of the car parking to provide 117 spaces, including EV provision.

An element of the works involves the proposed demolition of the existing teaching blocks within the southern part of the site, which are currently in need of replacement to better meet modern educational practices. The project will also be carefully phased to ensure the school is operational throughout construction.

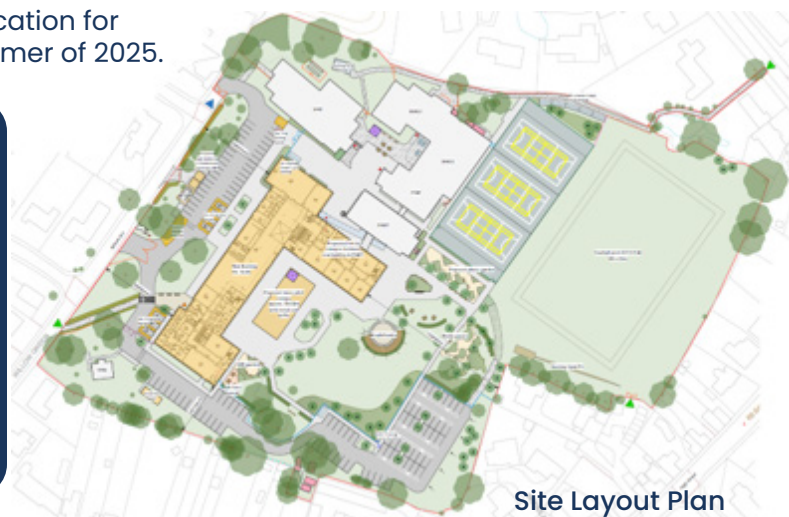
We are in the process of developing a planning application for submission to Brentwood Borough Council in the summer of 2025.
